ESSENTIALS:	
	Sweatshirt or Jacket
	Raincoat
	Secure, Closed - Toe Shoes
	Flashlight & Batteries
	Bug Repellent *
	Sunscreen
	Reusable water bottles totaling 2 liters
	Sunglasses
	Baseball cap or hat (for sun)
	Clothes you can get dirty
	Windbreaker
	An Extra pair of Shoes
	Sleeping Bag and Pillow
	Towel & Toiletries
	Bible (not your good one) and pen or pencil
	Two garbage bags (for dirty clothes)
Optional:	
	Camera & Extra Batteries
	Snack Money (T-shirts cost \$10 each, candy and soda \$1 each)
	Small Backpack

*Good quality recommended, due to exposure to ticks & mosquitos that could carry disease.

If your camper arrives without any of the essentials, we will provide them at your cost, unless prior arrangements have been made.

If you are Caving (ALL YES CAMPS):	
	Clothes that can get muddy or ripped
	An extra pair of boots or shoes to wear in cave
	Bring 2 AAA Batteries just for the cave
If you are Canoeing (ALL YES CAMPS):	
	Bathing Suit (modest, no bikinis or speedos)
	Shoes that can get wet
	Extra towel
If you are hiking:	
	Metal cup, bowl, and spoon

WHAT TO LEAVE BEHIND:	
	Cigarettes, drugs, alcohol, etc.
	Knives & weapons of any kind
	Clothes with negative messages or suggestive attire (halter tops, short shorts, bikinis/speedos)
	Radios, Ipods, & MP3 Players
	Cell Phones & Watches
	IPads, Tablets and other electronic devices



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
